2026 SCHOOL CHARGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS

The Canning Vale Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2026.

Voluntary Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$60.00 per student, which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000.

Your contribution will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. Your contribution will be used to supplement school funding for the purchase of resources needed in the provision of the learning program activities. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your voluntary contributions.

Other Voluntary Approved Requests

Canning Vale Primary School Board has approved a voluntary contribution of \$20 per student to be used for the improvement of the school grounds/playgrounds facilities for students.

Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions and activities for 2026 has been included in the table on the reverse of this letter. The amounts shown represent the maximum that can be charged for scheduled activities in 2026.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. Student Leader's Conference, Massed Choir program, etc.
- Other activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. Graduation activities (for example; dancing, lunch)
- Other services such as school photos and Year 6 Shirt/Jumper are optional and provided at a cost as advised by the supplier.
