## Whole School: Noongar Six Seasons

Aboriginal seasons are guided by the land. In the South West of Western Australia, Noongar people recognise six seasons, rather than the four seasons of the European calendar. These seasons are identified through changes in local plants, animals and weather patterns. Traditionally, Noongar people hunted and gathered food according to these seasonal changes, using signs in nature to understand which resources were plentiful at different times of the year.

Throughout Term 1, students have been learning about Bunuru (February–March), the hottest season, and how people and the environment respond during this time.

# Cottesloe Beach Swimming Recount

Every year, the Year 6's head off to beach swimming lessons at Cottesloe Beach. This is a recount of what this year's Year 6's did. All the students were excited for their beach swim!

On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of swimming we had to get sorted into our groups. Each group had to wear different coloured caps corresponding to their levels. We did some basic strokes to test our swimming skills. The higher levels practiced board rescues whilst the lower levels continued their swimming strokes. We got to see some sculptures by the sea (which is what we're learning in Art).

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the higher levels practiced "run, swim, run", which is where you run on the beach, then swim out to the ocean, then run again. The lower levels used swimming boards to help improve their swimming skills. Some groups got to play a game called "chin up, chin down". It is a game that tests your reaction skills.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day, the level 10-13's did their clothes swim (where you swim with clothes on) and they mastered their survival skills. Some of the other groups saw fish while they were swimming. Most of them loved it and tried to find more! They also made sandcastles and had lots of fun.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> day, for the level 9-13's, it was testing day, where the teachers assess your ability to swim so that they can be given a level. They learnt some rescue signs as well. For the beginner levels, they practised their short-distance swimming.

On the last day, it was a fun lesson for all levels! Most levels were given the choice to swim to the shark net and back. They saw many cool fish as well! For the other levels, they got to collect shells and build sandcastles.

All in all, beach swimming was a fun experience. Although the water was cold and salty, and the bus ride was long, everyone enjoyed their last primary school swimming lessons.

I value the school's strong sense of community, the dedication of its teachers, and the supportive environment that helps every child feel included and thrive.

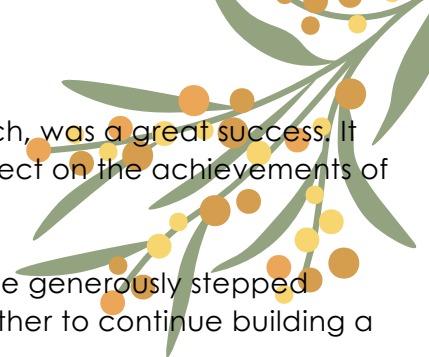

*Seasons for Growth* is an evidence-based change, loss and grief education program that uses the imagery of the seasons to illustrate the experience of change, loss and grief.

Children and young people can experience grief following significant changes and losses:

- ♦ Someone they love dies
- ♦ Separation and divorce
- ♦ Friendship changes
- ♦ Illness impacts their life
- ♦ Relocation
- ♦ Natural disasters

*Seasons for Growth* aims to strengthen the social and emotional wellbeing of children and young people by:

- ♦ Exploring the impact of change and loss on every-day life
- ♦ Learning new ways to respond to these changes.

### Program Structure

The *Seasons for Growth* Children and Young People's Program is a small group program which runs for 45 minutes over eight weeks. The program offers four levels with tailored, developmentally appropriate activities and discussions.

Level 1: 6-8 years

Level 2: 9-10 years

Level 3: 11-12 years

Level 4: 13-18 years

Each session explores a theme using the seasonal imagery:

- ♦ Life is like the Seasons
- ♦ Change is Part of Life
- ♦ Valuing My Story
- ♦ Caring for my Feelings
- ♦ Making Good Choices

The program provides a safe space for children and young people where they can give voice to their experiences, understand their feelings, learn problem-solving and decision making skills, develop friendships, and recognise they are not alone.

A *Seasons for Growth* journal is provided to each participant to document their learning journey.



Every two weeks in the program, we transition into a new "Season" as a metaphor for life's changes. Here is a picture of our Autumn set up. In the Autumn season, students explore the idea that change and loss are natural, and sometimes painful parts of our lives.



Students brought in their baby photos and toys in order to reflect on how much they have changed since they were a baby. This activity builds strong peer connections in the group as they bond over childhood, whilst also reminding students that change is within us and all around us.

The program is packed with a variety of activities designed to cater to a wide range of interests.
